New Born Screening Bolstered in PA

A recent wire report noted:

For years, specialists have urged that every U.S. newborn be tested for 29 rare but devastating genetic diseases, using that single heel-prick of blood, to catch the fraction who need fast treatment to avoid retardation, severe illness, even death. States gradually adopted those recommendations, and federal health officials say the testing catches about 5,000 babies a year with disorders ranging from sickle cell anemia to maple syrup urine disease and others with such tongue-twisting names that they go by acronyms like LCHAD.

In Pennsylvania, a new law passed last year requires testing for all 29 of these conditions.

The Winter Group is proud to report that it represented the March of Dimes and thousands of new born babies to get this law passed.
