Next Week's Primary Election

Next Tuesday marks Primary Election day here in the Commonwealth. The race for Governor on the Democratic side is led by Allegheny County Executive Dan Onorato, who has garnered 36% of voter support with one week to go, according to a recent Quinnipiac University poll. However some media sources note that geography will play an important role in this race. Onorato must face fellow Western PA native Auditor General Jack Wagner as well as two opponents from the east—State Senator Anthony Williams and Montgomery County Commissioner Joe Hoeffel. This could make it difficult for one candidate to win decisively in his home part of the state. With over a third of Democratic voters still undecided it's still too early to declare Onorato the clear cut favorite for next Tuesday's race.

On the Republican side, Attorney General Tom Corbett faces reinvigorated accusations of political motivation in joining 13 other Republican state attorneys general in a lawsuit opposing the federal health care reform law. Keystone Progress, a liberal advocacy group, points to communications between Corbett's office and a consultant for the Republican State Leadership Committee on the lawsuit prior to his decision to join the suit. But Corbett still remains comfortably in the lead ahead of State Representative Sam Rohrer in this race.

Budget Woes Worsening

As we reported last week, the state's April revenue numbers were released and showed the state to be short more than \$400 million from the anticipated projections. This brings the total revenue shortfall for this year to over \$1 billion. Senate Republican leaders last week sent letters to school superintendents across the state urging them to use caution when developing their budgets and not to count on the levels of spending enumerated in the Governor's proposed budget, which was based on revenue figures that that state failed to attain. Senate Republicans warn that no entity in the commonwealth should expect any guaranteed level of funding this year.

Solicitor General Elena Kagan Nominated to the Supreme Court

President Obama has nominated Solicitor General Elena Kagan to the Supreme Court. As solicitor general, Kagan represents the U.S. government and defends acts of Congress before the Supreme Court and decides when to appeal lower court rulings. Kagan, 50, would become the youngest member of the court and would become only the fourth woman to serve on the court. It would be the first time in history that three women would sit on the nine member bench.
