PA Primary Tomorrow

As a final recap, candidates running for the office of governor of Pennsylvania are Republican Tom Corbett, Republican Sam Rohrer, Democrat Dan Onorato, Democrat Jack Wagner, Democrat Anthony Williams and Democrat Joe Hoeffel. Corbett seems to be the front runner for the Republicans while Dan Onorato remains ahead in the four-way race for the Ds. Williams, who announced his running later than others and has less in his campaign bank account, has been running several TV and radio ads over the past few weeks.

As the primary closes in tomorrow, we can only help but think of the situations in West Virginia and Utah - when long-time incumbents lose their seats in this season's primary to challengers - in comparasion to Arlen Specter - Joe Sestak race. A Quinnipiac poll released today shows the Democratic race for U.S. Senate still too close to call. Sestak claimed 42 percent and Specter had 41 percent among Democrats likely to vote. However Specter continues to be a strong campaigner and has pulled through tight races before.

Over the weekend both Specter and Sestak agreed that which ever one wins the primary, they must work hard to keep Republican Pat Toomey out of the Senate seat.

House Approves Bill To Limit Drilling

PA House recently approved a bill authored by Rep. Dave Levdansky (D-Allegheny) that would place a three-year moratorium on leasing additional state forestland for Marcellus Shale natural gas drilling until the impacts of the drilling can be evaluated. To date, more than half of the 1.5 million acres of state forest in the gas drilling region have been leased for drilling. Levdansky and other legislators want to make sure the wells already drilled are working effectively before more are started.

The fate of this bill in the Senate remains unclear.

US Supreme Court Selection Process

President Obama has chosen Elena Kagan to fill the empty seat on the U.S. Supreme Court but a lot has to happen until then. Her confirmation hearing by the Senate Judiciary Committee is expected to begin this summer, with Obama and Democrats hoping she can be seated in time for the Supreme Court session this fall. She is expected to be confirmed but a lengthy hearing is still expected. Kagan served in the Clinton Administration in '90s and recently the White House has asked the National Archives to release 160,000 pages of documents during her previous time in the White House to help with the Senate hearing.
