## Budget Report

On Tuesday, Governor Ed Rendell and Democrats said they would seek closed-door negotiations to discuss a tax package instead of trying to bring it before the whole House. That same day several Representatives voiced strong concern during an attempt to pass a tax package. Democrats were hoping to discuss taxes in the week's budget meeting.

On Wednesday, legislative leaders held a meeting to continue budget negotiations. Reports say in the meeting leaders discussed how much can be spent in the upcoming fiscal year and less on possible taxes. The state is still waiting for Congress to approve \$850 million in Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) funding, which can make a big difference in how much money the state has to spend on projects other than Medicaid.

Last week in an address to the press, Gov. Rendell said his "proposed spend is \$29 billion overall with a state spend of \$26.2 billion. Both figures reflect a \$1.2 billion increase of which over \$1 billion is mandated increases by law."

Also last week, Governor Rendell sent a letter to House and Senate leaders asking them to keep legislators in Harrisburg until the budget is passed. The House is scheduled to be in session for the remainder of the month while the Senate's schedule is set for 3 days this week and 3 days next week. Both the House and Senate leaders have said they will amend their schedules as needed in order to get the budget passed as soon as possible.

## Pension Bill Passes House

Last week the House passed a detailed pension reform bill. The bill is meant to ease the burden on tax payers when the dramatic spike in pension costs goes into effect in a few years. The bill creates new rules for future employees who start in 2012 in an effort to streamline the public pension for the future. HB 2497 now moves to the Senate for consideration.
