Dear H1 Bargaining Unit Member:

The Commonwealth Court is the court that is critical to us as state employees and union members—the court that hears collective bargaining and arbitration award cases, workers compensation and unemployment compensation, Pennsylvania Labor Relations Board appeals, and cases where the state government is sued. The Commonwealth Court is the court that is currently reviewing the State's appeal of our Contract Arbitration Award. **PSCOA has endorsed Kathryn Boockvar for this position**, because she has worked on behalf of the working people of Pennsylvania for her entire career.
