On Thursday evening, May 13, 2010, State Representative Sheryl DeLozier of Cumberland County held a town hall meeting regarding the Department of Corrections plans to close towers at SCI Camp Hill. The meeting was arranged at request of the PSCOA and President Don McNany and Vice President Percy Poindexter, along with several Officers from Camp Hill, attended.

Local residents voiced their concerns to the Department's spokesperson Susan McNaughton, who held to the Department's line that the move does not place the public or staff in danger.

The PSCOA will continue to fight this ill conceived plan with all available resources and encourages all our members to contact your local Representatives and Senators asking them to oppose this plan.
